PPGC STATS POLICY AND GOVERNANCE

16 PPGC members

2,500 plus PPGC Volunteer hours

In 2024, **716** Policy Submissions and **155** Governance Resolutions, including **16** transferred from Policy to Governance

291 duplicate policy submissions sent to **68** CA Policy Working Groups

203 Policy Final Submissions sent to Ranking Stage

72 out of 87 CAs had at least one submission from either member or CA P&G committee

48 CAs final round of submissions approved respective CA Boards

Multiple CA-supported submissions: **68** Policy CA Working Groups, **51** made the final list

Final Governance submissions: **155** submissions by Members from **38** CAs across **all 5** Regions, with **80** CA Board approved, then **54** sent to ranking

Governance Working Groups: **66** submissions for **18** working groups, with **9** involving only **2** submissions each.
