The “Strong and Free Awards” recognize those who’ve gone above and beyond in their service, embodying the spirit of Alberta and our party’s values. Awards will be presented at the party’s Annual General Meeting in Calgary taking place **November 3-4, 2023**.

Exceptional Fundraiser Award

Exceptional Campaign Manager Award

Regional Volunteer of the Year Award (five awards)
